Snickerdoodle Cookies

- 1 cup butter, *softened*
- 1 + ¼ cup granulated sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 2 + ¾ cups all-purpose flour
- 1 + ½ teaspoons cream of tartar
- ½ teaspoon baking soda
- ½ teaspoon salt

For the cinnamon sugar coating:

- ¼ cup granulated sugar
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon



In a small mixing bowl, combine sugar and cinnamon and stir until incorporated. In a stand mixer with the paddle attachment on medium speed (or a large mixing bowl with a hand mixer), cream together butter and sugar until light and fluffy, about 2 minutes. Add in eggs and vanilla and mix until combined. Add flour, cream of tartar, baking soda, and salt, and mix until just combined. Cover the bowl with plastic cling wrap and chill for 20-30 minutes. Preheat oven to 350 F. Line 2 large half sheet baking pans with parchment paper or a silicone baking mat. Scoop out about 2 tablespoons of cookie dough and roll into a ball (about 1-inch thick). Roll each cookie ball into the cinnamon-sugar to coat it completely. Place the cookie balls on the lined baking sheets, spacing them about 2 -3 inches apart. Bake for 9-11 minutes. Allow the cookies to cool on the baking sheet for 10 minutes, then carefully transfer to a wire cooling rack to cool completely.
